Green Valley camp out 6/9 - 6/11

Directions: Drive on Highway 30 to the junction with Highway 330 (east of San Bernardino near Highland). Take Highway 330 North (signed “Mountain Resorts”) and drive to Running Springs and the junction with Highway 18. Turn east on Highway 18 and drive to Green Valley Road. Turn left on Green Valley Road and drive three miles to Forest Road 3N16 (a dirt road). Turn left and drive four miles (you will cross two creeks that vary in depth depending on the season; high clearance is recommended but is typically not necessary) to the campground (one mile past the town of Green Valley Lake).

This camp is new to us. It sits along pretty Green Valley Creek at an elevation of 7,000 feet. Little Green Valley Lake is a mile to the west. The lake is stocked with trout and is also a good spot to take a flying leap and belly flop! Sounds like we might be swimming and fishing that weekend!
